## THE REALM OF BUDDING WRITERS

### THE PARTITION - THE DARKEST MOMENT IN INDIAN HISTORY

Jinnah, Nehru, and Patel told me they wanted a line before or on the 15th of August. So I drew them a line. ~ Sir Cyril Radcliffe. Most of you probably think that the division of our great country should have been well-judged, pondered over and a decision that would have taken anyone quite some time to make, as it should have been, since we are talking about the division of a whole nation here. You will be startled to find the somewhat cruel and slightly bitter truth about the partition of India. In March 1947, Lord Louis Mountbatten was appointed as the Viceroy of India with orders to transfer power to India by July 1948, this decision was preponed to August 1947, nearly a year ahead of schedule. To ensure that the country would not be divided unfairly, Lord Mountbatten brought in a British lawyer, Sir Cyril Radcliffe, yes, a lawyer, not a cartographer and not someone acquainted with the Indian subcontinent and its population, to draw the borders (called the Radcliffe Lines). He was given five weeks to sketch the boundaries of India and Pakistan, and he managed to accomplish this task in three days. All of this was done in absolute secrecy. In fact, the locations of the borders were not made public after two days of the partition, the people moving between India and Pakistan were moving around frantically with no clue where the boundaries were. Two days, of slaughter, bloodshed and suffering. If this isn't unjust and inadequate, what is?

### SCHOLARSHIP TEST - 28th January 2024


